To qualify for authority to prescribe buprenorphine for the treatment of opioid dependence, DATA 2000 requires physicians to complete not less than 8 hours of training. This 8-hour blended course (4-hour online and 4-hour in-person) addresses those requirements using curriculum approved by CSAT/SAMHSA and ASAM (American Society of Addiction Medicine.) NoRxAbuse, through funding provided by the California Healthcare Foundation, is offering training for prescribers in a blended format through 4 hours of independent self-paced learning followed by a 4-hour interactive and engaging face to face training led by national experts. At the end of the ASAM course, NoRxAbuse will facilitate a discussion of North State resources and initiatives to combat the local opioid epidemic will be discussed. Participants will take the 4-hour online course then attend the in-person training on January 28th in Shasta County.
